THE EUROPEAN DECISION PROCESS

IN THE EUROPEAN UNION THERE ARE THREE INSTITUTIONS

1. European Commission

1. Are publishing drafts for regulation and directives
2. After publishing a draft, a commissioner has the responsibility to get an agreement between the Parliament and the Council

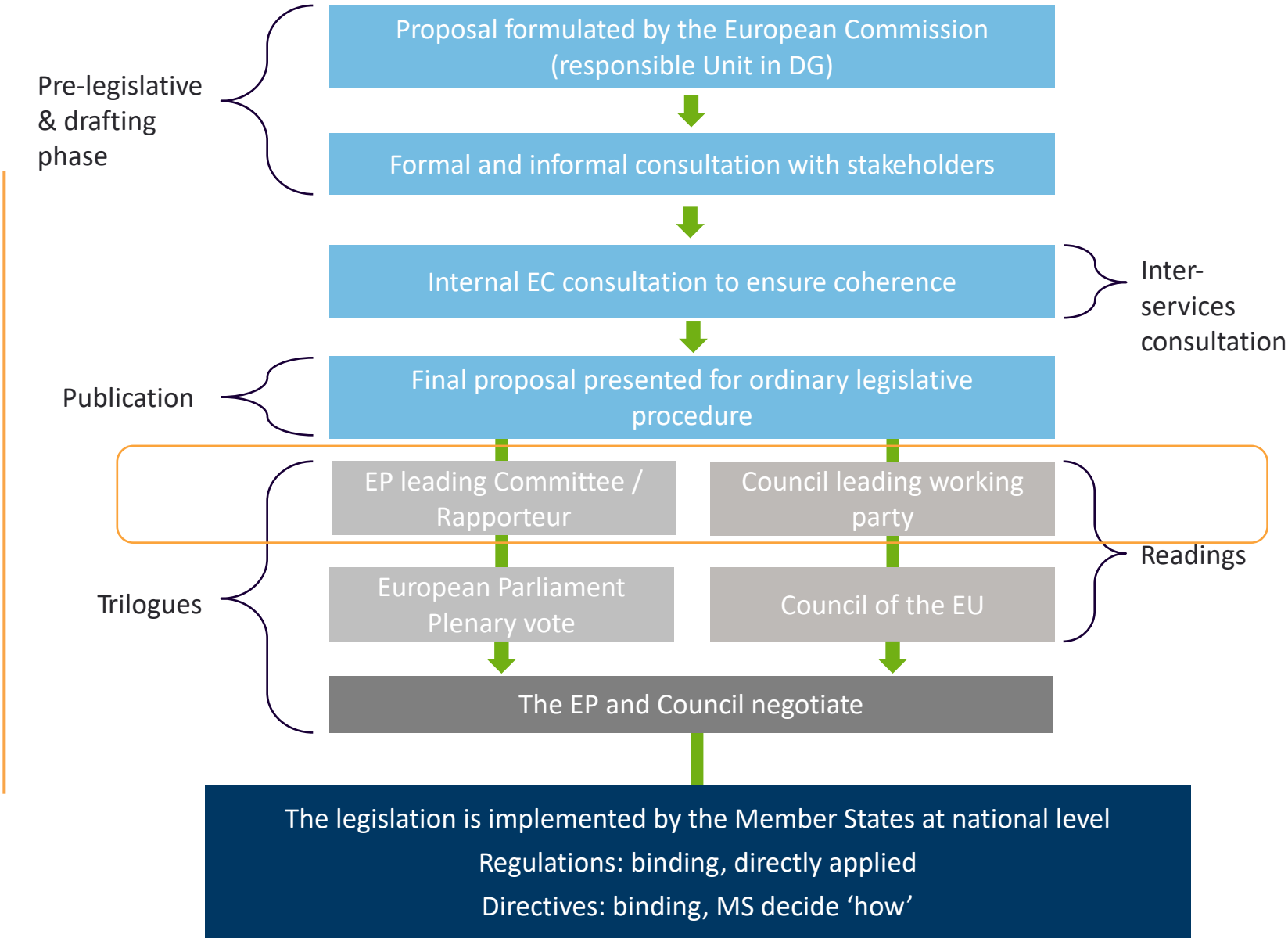
2. European Parliament

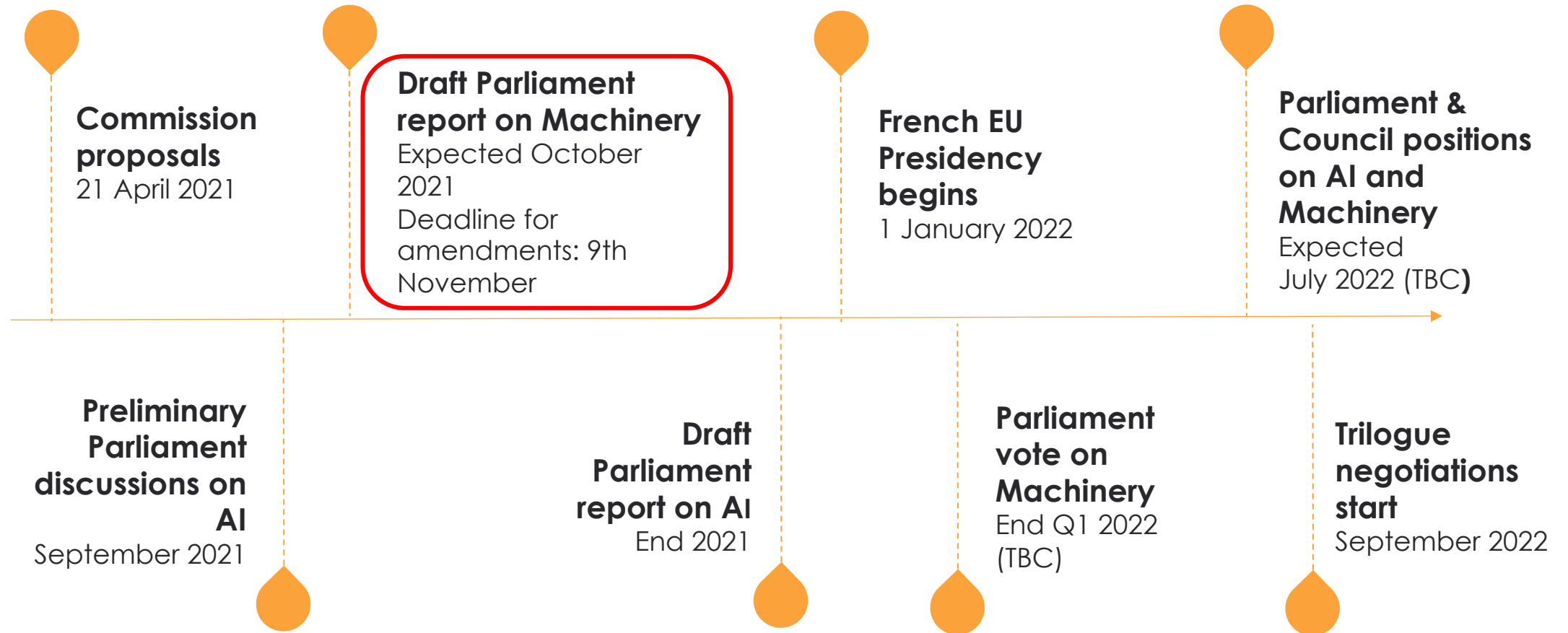
1. Are directly elected politicians from the member states divided between seven political-groups. Each group select a group of main-negotiators.
2. The Parliament elect a leading committee/rapporteur to negotiate with the Council

3. European Council

1. Is representatives from the member states
2. Every member state has the right to veto a regulatory/directive

WHERE ARE WE IN THE PROCESS?

STEP 1: CLARIFICATION AND DIALOGUE

1. There are many interests and intentions behind both the Machinery Directive and the AI Regulation.
2. It is crucial to ensure a clarification of whether we read the proposals and the expected consequences correctly.
3. We have initiated a dialogue with the relevant stakeholders.
